THE COVID YEARS

2019	The best festival ever!
2020	Event cancelled, initially to September,
	then to May 2021
2021	Festival held 10 th to 12 th September
2022	Festival returned to May - 20th to 22nd
2023	Reduced 'KMF Trail Running Weekend'
2024	Back to the full festival, with tweaks

STRATEGIC REVIEW = ISSUES

- Local relations have been 'up and down' over the years and could be better
 - Greater emphasis on competitive sport than guided activities
 - Live music kept visitors in the Festival Village until 10.30pm
- Live music evenings increasingly difficult to 'police'
- £1.3m economic impact, but no support from the local authority
- Very difficult to make any money out of this event, need to reduce financial risk and increase loyalty

STRATEGIC REVIEW = STRENGTHS

- Location the Keswick factor is critical and a privilege
 - The town itself is a incredibly loved
 - The surrounding fells and lakes provide the perfect playground
- Established event with strong following amongst visitors and outdoor trade
- Expertise in sporting events management
- Opportunity to breakdown barriers to the outdoors
- £1.3m economic impact


